In April 2019, after the completion of site acceptance tests of our marine simulators, the first seminar on MAN ME-C elec tronically controlled engine took place by our N. Daniil. It was the first ever seminar at ENGINE ATHINA. At that time, our company had 7 oil tankers under its management with such a main engine including the ME-B

of Minerva Leo and Minerva Tychi. Now we have 15 ships in total with this type of engine, and this training course is gradually enriched, recently by adding the Exhaust Gas Recirculation system of Minerva Kallisto, performance adjustments in the MOP, etc.
